

### **Transport/Parking**

Request for transport from County Hall to the ground. Shuttlebus? Parking to be available at the stadium car park for disabled supporters. Question was asked on whether players needed to park at the ground.

Wheelchair users find it traumatic on Kerrison Road.

## **Changing Facilities/Accessible Toilets**

Not always easy to access accessibility toilets. More are needed around the stadium. Some need access to changing facilities.

Currently, accessibility toilets aren't wide enough for the user, carer and wheelchair. Request for toilets to be wider.

### Lifts

Regency lift to upper tier has sometimes been broken which has led to supporters missing games due to not being able to get to their seat via the stairs.

Joma lift only goes to the second level and not the top level. A few disabled supporters have had to walk the stairs which can be difficult.

### Gallery



Request for the microphone in the Gallery to be fixed so that supports can hear the atmosphere which JHT states in the season ticket renewal letter. Supporters haven't heard this atmosphere for a new seasons now.



Lights are shining too bright from the stand into the Gallery. Possible strip of green tape could help block this out.
